

Onna Village Disaster Prevention Map (Northern Area)



1 Manzamo
(Place of Scenic Beauty Designated by Okinawa Prefecture)
A 20-meter-high cliff of Ryukyu limestone and a park filled with lawn on top. It is said that the king of Ryukyu, Sho Kei, praised it as 'a field large enough to seat 10,000 people' and gave it its name. Beautiful sunset at dusk is a must-see.



1 Manzamo Area Revitalization Facility
A facility with souvenir shops, restaurants, exhibition space, and an observation deck. It is a three-story building with local specialty shops on the first floor, restaurants and stores on the second floor, and an observation deck with a panoramic view of the ocean on the third floor.

Remember the disaster communication method

NTT's "Disaster Emergency Message Dial" and mobile phone companies' "Disaster Message Board Services" are useful to confirm the safety of family or supporters, as telephone calls often do not go through during disasters. This service is activated in the event of a large-scale disaster such as an earthquake with an intensity of 6 or higher.

How to use the Disaster Emergency Message Dial: 171
*You will hear voice guidance, so please follow it calmly.

How to leave a message: 171 ▶ 1 ▶ telephone number (starting with the area code) of the person in the disaster area ▶ Leave the message

How to play the message: 171 ▶ 2 ▶ telephone number (starting with the area code) of the person in the disaster area ▶ Listen to the message





The water/sediment disaster announcement details have been updated.

There are lots of disaster information. When should I evacuate? **No one should be left behind**

Everyone must evacuate at Alert Level 4 !!

Evacuation timing is announced using [Alert Levels].

Evacuation information is announced using (Alert Levels) from the 2019 flooding season (around June). People living in areas where (Alert Level ② or ③) is issued by local municipalities should evacuate immediately.

- Alert Level ①** Stay alert (issued by Japan Meteorological Agency)
- Alert Level ②** Check evacuation procedures (issued by Japan Meteorological Agency)
- Alert Level ③** Elderly and others needing care should evacuate (issued by local municipalities)
- Alert Level ④** Evacuation Instruction (emergency) Everyone must evacuate! (issued by local municipalities)

At (Alert Level ④) (issued by local municipalities), a disaster has already occurred.
